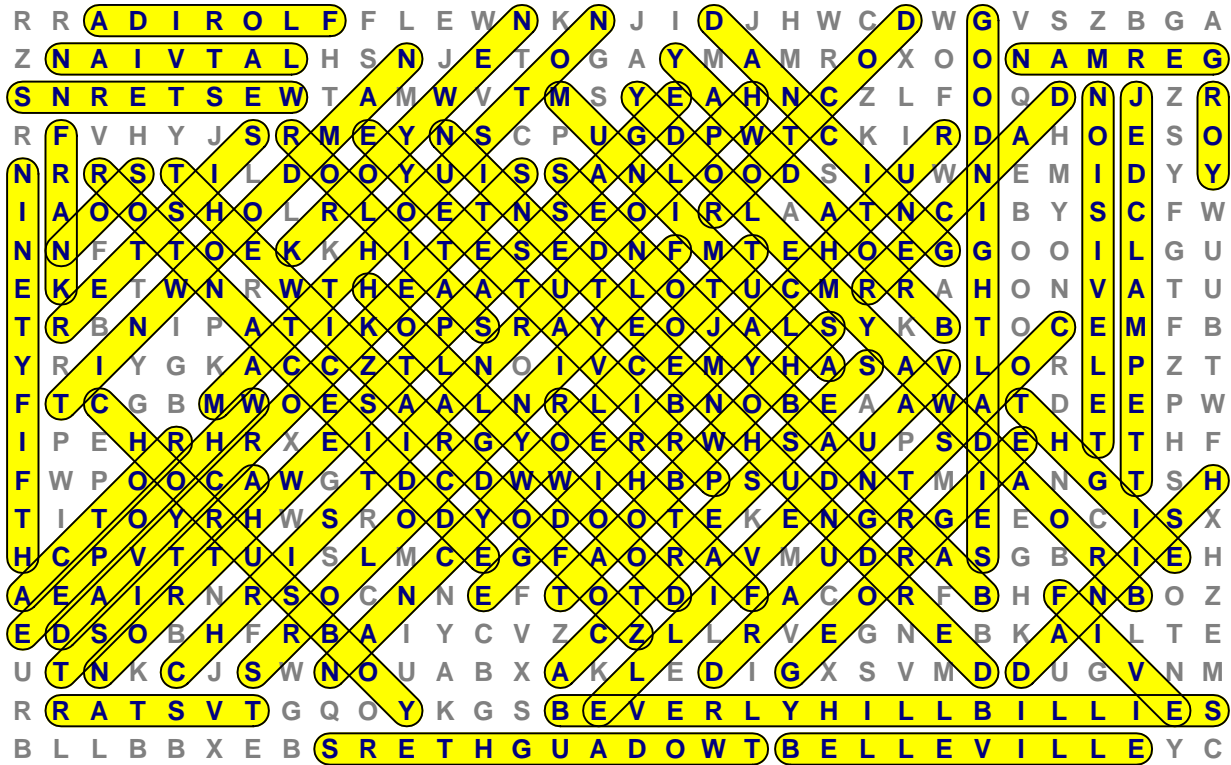
**Find the answers for each blank and circle them in the grid.

He continued to do more vaudeville and a few movies for RKO. He later played on stage in the farce (31) "_____". From 1943 to 1945, Buddy enlisted and served in The United States (32) _____ as 1st Lieutenant and Executive Officer. In 1945, he divorced and married his second wife (33) _____. He played (34) _____ in the (35) _____ revival of (36) "_____". He began to become involved with (37) _____ which was relatively new. As he began, he had worked in several (38) _____. He had great success as (39) _____ pal (40) _____ in the Walt Disney TV movies in 1955-56. Then he later played a regular role in the TV series (41) "_____".

In 1962, Buddy Ebsen began to star in the TV series "The (42) _____" as (43) _____, an offer that turned him into a (44) _____. This story of a hillbilly family that becomes rich and moves to Beverly Hills went down very well with the audience. After some more TV movies and guest roles, Buddy got the title role in the series (45) "_____" in 1973, playing a (46) _____, who was again very popular. In the mid-eighties he played Matt's uncle (47) _____ in the third season of (48) "_____". He was an avid (49) _____ and also an accomplished (50) _____, which flourished later in life.
