Spielberg's first feature film was in 1974. The **SUGARLAND EXPRESS** was the comedy/drama based on the true story of a fugitive couple who flees the authorities with their child, whom they refuse to give up for adoption. It won critical acclaim including a **CANNES FILM** Festival Award in 1974 for **BEST SCREENPLAY**.

In 1975, Spielberg directed **JAWS**. Only his second feature film, it was a huge success. It was nominated for best film at the 1976 **ACADEMY AWARDS**, and won 3 Oscars for **EDITING**, **SOUND** and **ORIGINAL score**. Due to its popularity, it would open up the doors for Spielberg to work on many more great projects.

Spielberg would go on to create films such as **CLOSE ENCOUNTERS**, **E.T.**, **RAIDERS OF THE LOST ARK**, **SCHINDLER'S LIST**, **JURASSIC PARK** and **SAVING PRIVATE RYAN**.

In 1982, Spielberg founded the company, **AMBLIN ENTERTAINMENT** using the name of his first **PROFESSIONAL FILM** and the popular logo from the movie E.T. which was the first popular movie created by it. It was only a **PRODUCTION STUDIO**, and never distributed its own movies.

It worked with other studios such as Universal Pictures, Columbia Pictures and Warner Brother Studios. His studio was an immediate success and many of its movies became **ICONS**.

In 1994 **DREAMWORKS SKG** became the first new movie studio in **HOLLYWOOD** in over 75 years. The partnership between Steven Spielberg, **JEFFERY KATZENBERG**, and **DAVID GEFFEN** formed a media company that would reach into the fields of live action and animated movies, **MUSIC**, **COMPUTER** games, arcades, television production and **MOVIE** distribution.

By 1997, Spielberg's annual income had reached \$283 (**TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY THREE**)million. He was the highest paid entertainment figure of that year.
